

Medicare Required Clinical Documentation For Spinal Bracing

At least one of the following must be documented

- 1. Reduce pain by restricting mobility of the trunk, **OR**
- 2. Facilitate healing following an injury to the spine or related soft tissues,

- Facilitate healing following a surgical procedure on the spine or related soft tissue, <u>OR</u>
- 4. Otherwise support weak spinal muscles and/or a deformed spine.
- 5. If replacing an existing brace, it must be documented why the current brace

is not functioning for the patient.

Medicare does not consider comfort, convenience, or brace is old & worn out as a justifiable reason for replacement of an orthosis.

If custom fabrication is required you must state that a custom brace is required, the patient cannot use an off the shelf brace and explain why. Medicare will not cover a spinal brace if used strictly for positioning in a wheelchair. The reason for limiting or restricting motion must be documented.
