

## **Medicare Physician Documentation Requirements for Prosthetics**

- a. Expectation of Functional Ability
  - Patient's functional capabilities **prior** to amputation
  - Patient's current functional capabilities
  - His/her **expected** functional potential (for lower extremity, include the K-Level)
  - Explanation for the difference.
- b. Historical documentation of the current prosthesis/component(s)
  - History of amputation; include level of amputation and side.
  - History of the prosthesis/components being replaced
  - Description of the labor involved (we can provide this information if needed)
  - Reason for replacement (e.g. change in physiological condition; irreparable change in the condition of the prosthesis/component(s)
- c. Patient's **current** and **past** residual limb condition, shape and/or volume. Note any increase or decrease. Skin condition along with any risk factors i.e diabetes.
- d. Patient's desire to use the prosthesis being ordered or to ambulate.
- e. Written order.
